

Condolence to the families of the victims and to all Polish people



This morning near Smolensk has crashed the landing plane with the Polish delegation on board which was going to the commemorative events in Katyn. Among the deceased there are also the Polish President Lech Kaczynski and his wife. We express our condolence to the families of the victims and to all Polish nation.

Tomorrow, April 11, in Saint Petersburg two religious services for victims will take place. At 10.00 in the Franciscan monastery of San Antonio Miracle-Worker (9th Krasnoarmeyskaya, 10a) and at 13.30 in the Catholic Church of St. Catherine (Nevskiy Prospekt 32/34) there will be services for President of the Republic of Poland Lech Kaczynski and his wife Mary Kaczynski and for all who tragically perished in the accident near Smolensk on April 10, 2010.

12 April is proclaimed the day of national mourning in Russia.

The relations between Russia and Poland, despite the proximity of the two Slavic countries in terms of geography and of origin, have almost always been strained and now, after the tragedy, the Russians fear that instead of consolidation through the common sorrow their relations will cool off even more, up to the hate.
